Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.

Atmaana Business Consulting operate a highly efficient and cost effective distributed organizational and operational business model whereby we hold no emissions producing facilities, vehicles, or other assets.

As a result, our scope 1 & 2 emissions, as defined in the GHG Protocol, will be baselined to 0.

This also reduces our emissions from the following GHG Protocol Scope 3 categories to 0:

(4) Upstream transportation and distribution, (5) Waste generated by operations, (7) Employee commuting, (9) Downstream transportation and distribution.

The only reportable Source 3 carbon emissions are from (6) Business Travel. 2025 Business Travel carbon emissions have been baselined in accordance with the distance based method using the rail and unknown car figures from the DEFRA Greenhouse gas reporting conversion factors 2025.

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we will adopt the following carbon reduction targets. We will reduce our carbon emissions by 1.42 tCO₂e 2030, this is a 15% reduction over 5 years.

Going forward we will also provide a further set of tCO₂e figures normalised to business turnover to track our efficiency in carbon outputs in relation to business activity. Further analysis and carbon auditing will be developed during the remainder of the current financial year to further pinpoint areas for improvement and develop further targets and carbon reduction projects.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

Our dispersed company structure has removed our Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions, and we will commit to keeping ourselves asset light to maintain our carbon neutral position. This means holding no company fleet or offices.

In 2025 our work to promote rail travel and more carbon friendly planning of meetings has resulted in a 28% reduction compared to our baseline 2024.

In the future we will implement further measures such as:

- Promotion of rail travel as the preferred option when travelling on Atmaana related business.
- Planning in person meetings in areas with strong public transport links to give as many of our Associates the option to take public transport instead of drive.
- Continuing to promote remote and hybrid working.
- Discuss progress on carbon emission targets in the quarterly whole company meetings including encouraging Associates to phase out older carbon emitting vehicles in favour of electric vehicles in line with the Governments ban on the sale of new petrol and diesel cars by 2030.
